WHAT WILL TETRAGUARD DO FOR YOUR SHOWPIGS?

TetraGuard is a treatment of bacterial enteritis in show pigs caused by *Escherichia coli* and *Salmonella choleraesuis* and bacterial pneumonia caused by *Pasteurella multocida* susceptible to chlortetracycline and for the control of swine dysentery associated with *Brachyspira* (formerly *Serpulina* or *Treponema*) *hyodysenteriae* susceptible to tiamulin.

FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

Mix 1lbs of TetraGuard with 50lbs of complete swine feed to make a Type C medicated feed supplying 400G/Ton of Chlortetracycline and 35G/Ton of Tiamulin Hydrogen Fumerate. Feed the resulting complete Type C medicated feed at a rate of 0.05lbs/pound of bodyweight/day to supply 10mg of Chlortetracycline/lb of bodyweight/day. Feed continuously as the sole ration to finishing swine for 14 days.

EXAMPLE:

3lbs of feed X 0.02=0.06lbs of TetraGuard

50lbs of feed X 0.02=1.0lbs of TetraGuard
